

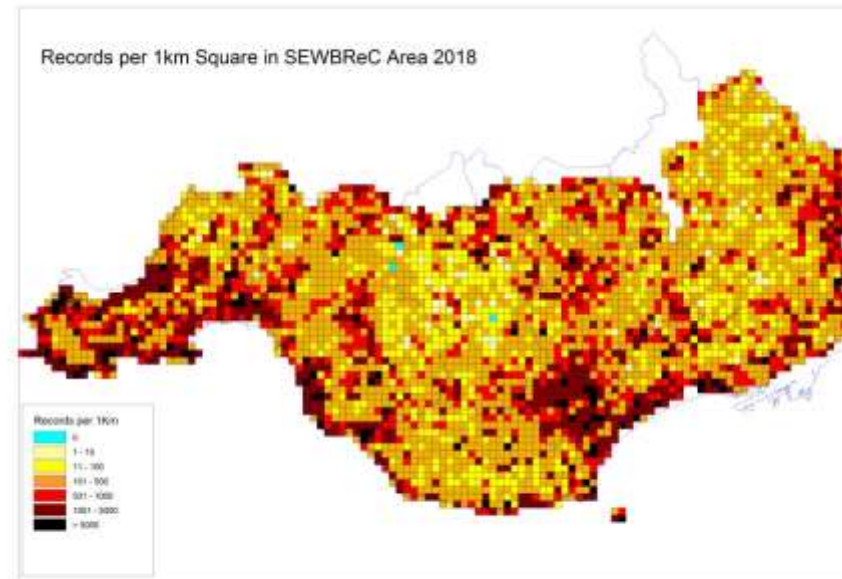

27 taxa groups

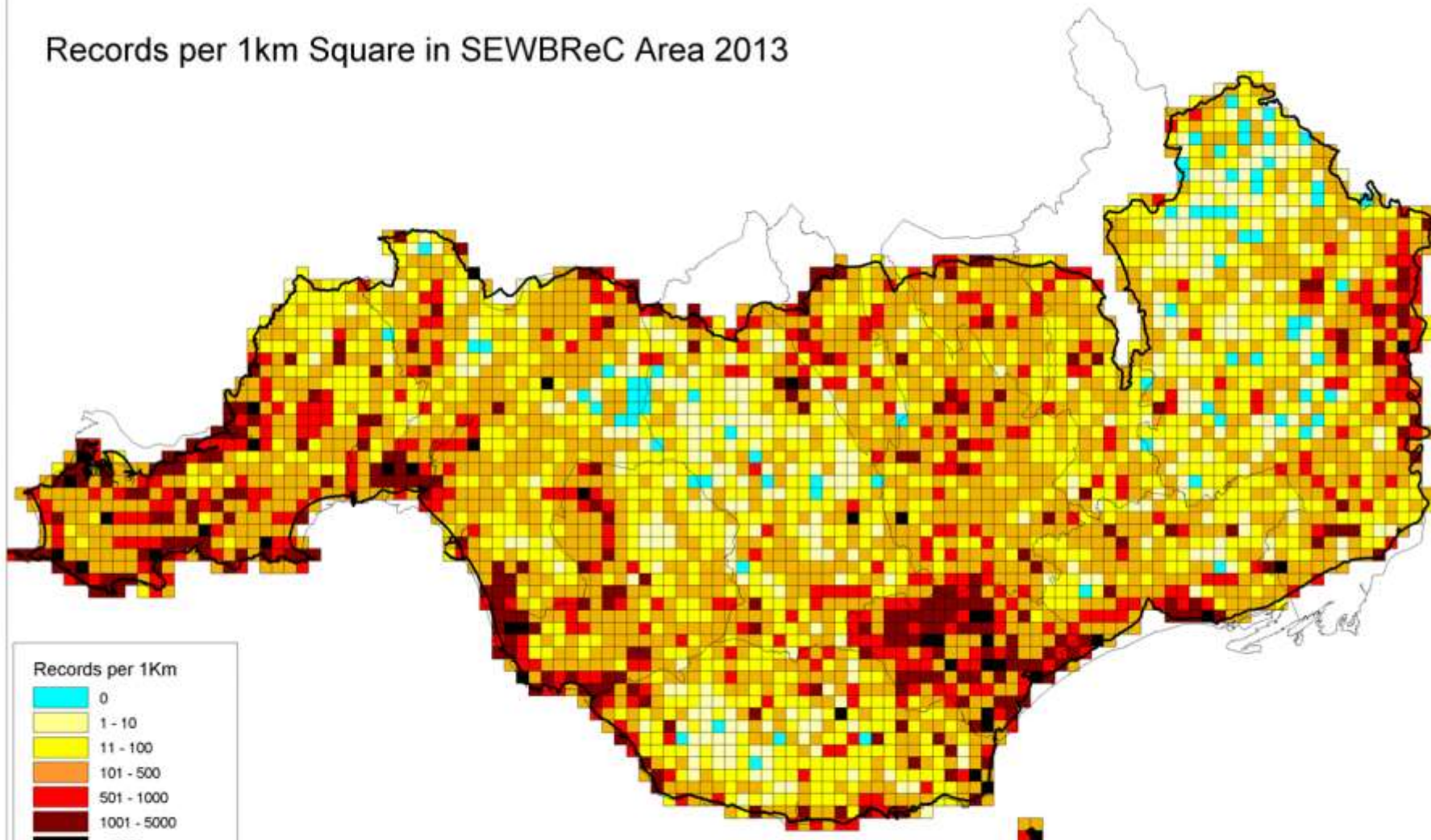
